The UKEOF Catalogue provides access to information about environmental observations, offering a unique UK overview. Last year, UKEOF launched the [new upgraded version](#) which enables easier access to more up to date information on the UK's monitoring programmes. The upgraded Catalogue facilitates joint-working, leading to more comprehensive and efficient monitoring activities.

Check your organisation's records

The Catalogue needs input from the community to ensure that the records are up to date. This will help facilitate decision-making that is based on up to date and relevant information. Every organisation can now update its own contents using the new editor tool. Why not check your organisation's records? Catalogue features

- **Mapping search tool** – provides an extra dimension to the search capability. Users can see where observations are being carried out in a certain area, find out where facilities are located or look at the coverage of a specific programme.
- **Advanced search box** – instantly returns results to the user.

Other features allow users access to information such as:

- Which activities are involved in a specific monitoring network
- Which organisation operates in a particular monitoring site
- How many sites collect data for a monitoring programme
- How many monitoring sites an organisation operates in
